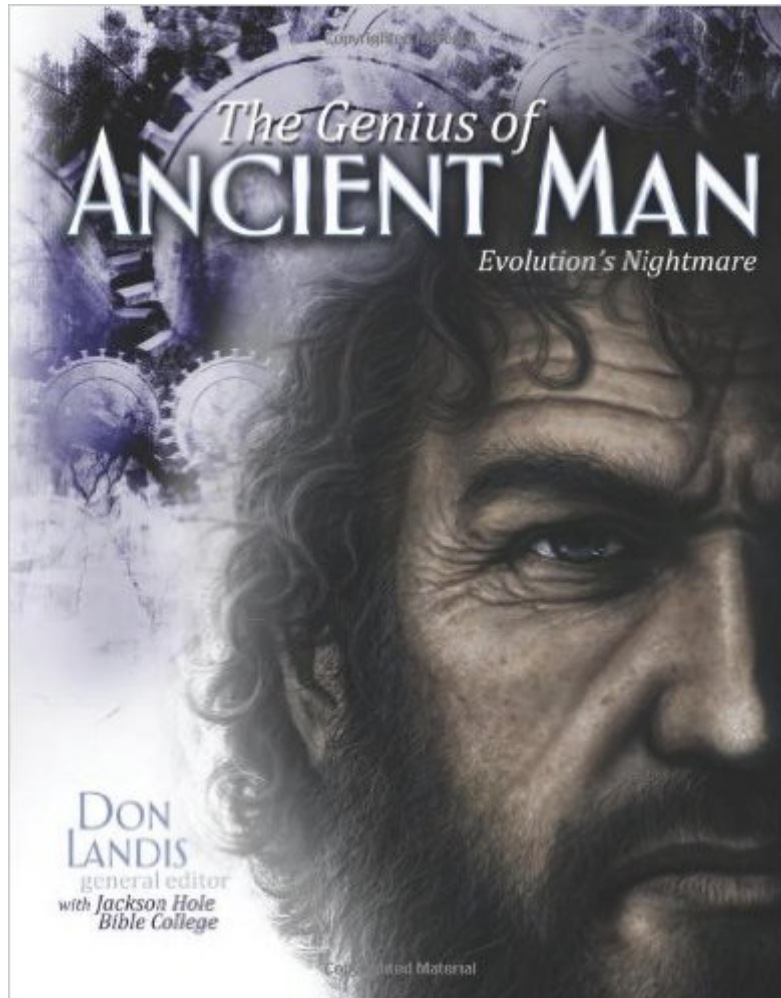

From the title, the premise of the book is that God created man perfect, including his intellect. From the very beginning of time, mankind has possessed many creative and intellectual abilities that far surpass even the most learned in our own time. But this isn't what the evolutionists would have us believe. In order for their "theory" to hold true, man would have to evolve from an unintelligent ape

into a supreme fount of knowledge. This isn't what we see when we examine ancient history. The Genius of Ancient Man: Evolution's Nightmare is an extremely well-researched textbook on the intelligence and accomplishments of ancient man. An important concept related to this intelligence, is the fact that it was there before man was dispersed at the Tower of Babel. We know this because the same abilities are seen all over the world in all different cultures. For instance, several cultures around the world have succeeded in building towers and structures that boggle the minds of present day scholars. These cultures didn't have Google to look up "how to build a ziggurat" and there were no YouTube videos to teach "construction methods of ancient pyramids." This was information that was passed down to the cultures from their ancestors...their common ancestors. It was also at the Tower of Babel that Satan showed his desire to counterfeit the things of the Lord. One of the first counterfeits was the tower itself. But there have been many, many more counterfeits over time.

Disappointing because of its potential I have mixed feelings about this book. In terms of format, it's quite well presented. This was not what I thought it was going to be (perhaps for lack of reading the description more carefully), and is a large, somewhat thin hardback of the sort picture books for NatGeo or children might be. The information is written more like a primer for older children as to the likelihood of Biblical overlap of events such as Noah's Flood or Babel with existing so-called Out of Place Artifacts. Two general comments stood out among those I looked at prior to ordering the book. A number of people commented on how dogmatic it came across. I was perhaps less sensitive to this, simply because I've read a lot of books written that way and could forgive a lot while I thought the basic premise was right and I held out hope that the book would support the premise well. The book is presented as "others teach evolution; the Bible teaches creation, flood, Babel; here is the evidence; the evidence supports this". A lot of us, being familiar with the discussion, may have been hoping for a softer, more analytical touch: "here's an enormous amount of detail, things that are hard to explain in the current model, but if the Bible is telling the truth, then its explanation makes sense of what we're seeing." That's not an argument against Biblical inerrancy. I believe it is inerrant. But it's a style of argumentation, leveraging reason, that lends itself well to discussing this with others. You don't have to take the author's word for it; here's a preponderance of evidence. The second comment expressed disappointment that this book can't be used for witnessing, and I think it's right.

I just spent hours today pouring over The Genius of Ancient Man by Don Landis. The subject matter is just fascinating! This book sets out to support the Biblical position of man being created

intelligently, and of Babel being the origin from where people spread out across the earth. People with an evolutionary mindset believe that man started out simple and has progressively gotten smarter and more advanced. Even Christians typically assume that we are the most advanced that any civilization has been since the beginning of time. Mr. Landis sets out to change our mind on the subject. He explains how Adam and Eve were the smartest people ever on the earth because they were created first, perfectly, in God's image, and with no mutations or sickness like we have now. They also had communion with God, so they probably had access to infinitely more knowledge than we do. After they sinned, man's abilities and intellect slowly decreased as the fallen world took a toll on their bodies and minds. Mr. Landis speculates that by the time of the flood, ancient man may have been very, very advanced (there was about 1500 years between creation and the flood, after all, and think about all that we have been able to accomplish in just the past couple of hundred years!) There is no way to prove this, because everything was wiped out in the flood and then Noah and his family had to start from scratch again. Mr. Landis goes on to show example after example of how ancient civilizations in different areas of the world shared similarities early on, pointing to a common starting place (Babel). He also shows many examples of advanced things that researchers have found, but cannot explain because they do not think that ancient man was very advanced or intelligent.
