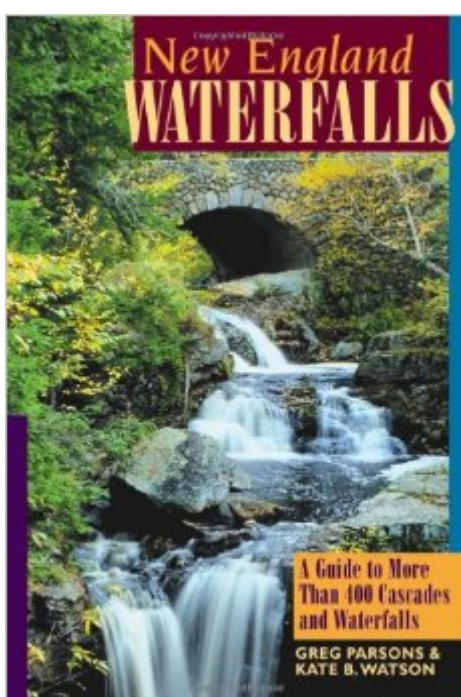

This is a good book. The individual waterfalls are well explained. It would be better if there were small detailed regional maps identifying where to find each location instead of one large map of the whole state.

I have now used this media for the last 2 years of vacations. First year I mapped out using their online site. This year I HAD TO HAVE the book!! It came in handy on those long hikes with trails not marked very well. Very detailed and will bring you to some breathtaking places. I plan to visit many many more that are listed.

Don't get the Kindle edition. For me, this was supposed to be a reference to find and explore the falls. For that purpose, the Kindle edition is very frustrating. With zero links in the document, and lists and state maps presented as low resolution images, I found myself writing down numbers and names of the nearby falls and then doing text searches to find info on each one. There's apparently no good way to cross reference or navigate this book. Good content, lousy Kindle conversion.

This is one very awesome and informative book. It lists all waterfalls in New England that are big enough to keep them running most if not all of the year round. The book shows you by state how many are in each state and the approximate area in which to find them. They then go on to give you a detailed listing of each of them and where to find them. Living in New Hampshire this is one of my bucket list items. I want to visit and photograph as many as I can and this book will be a wonderful reference to put in my back pack during the better months when I can get around. Was one of the best purchases I've made in some time on a non fiction book.

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
