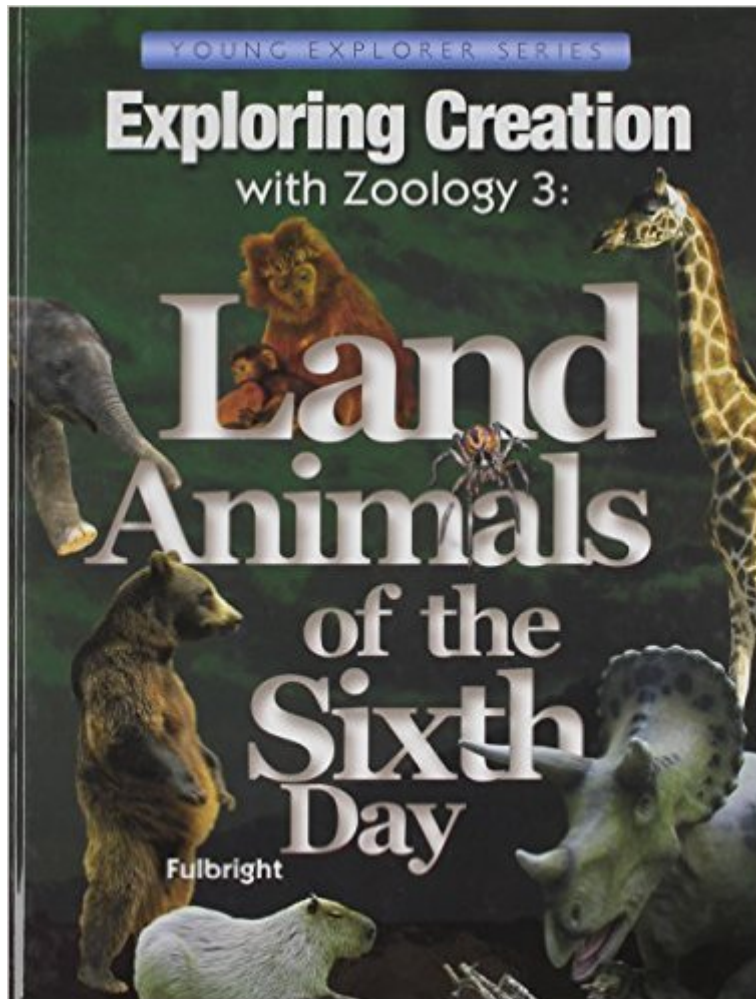

The Zoology books are taught from an immersion approach. This means your child will be fully immersed in the study of land animals. This includes classification and binomial nomenclature (scientific names). The beginning of the book has a list of all items needed for each lesson. presented at a higher level than most elementary science books. Regardless, your child will still learn everything necessary, and have fun doing it.
