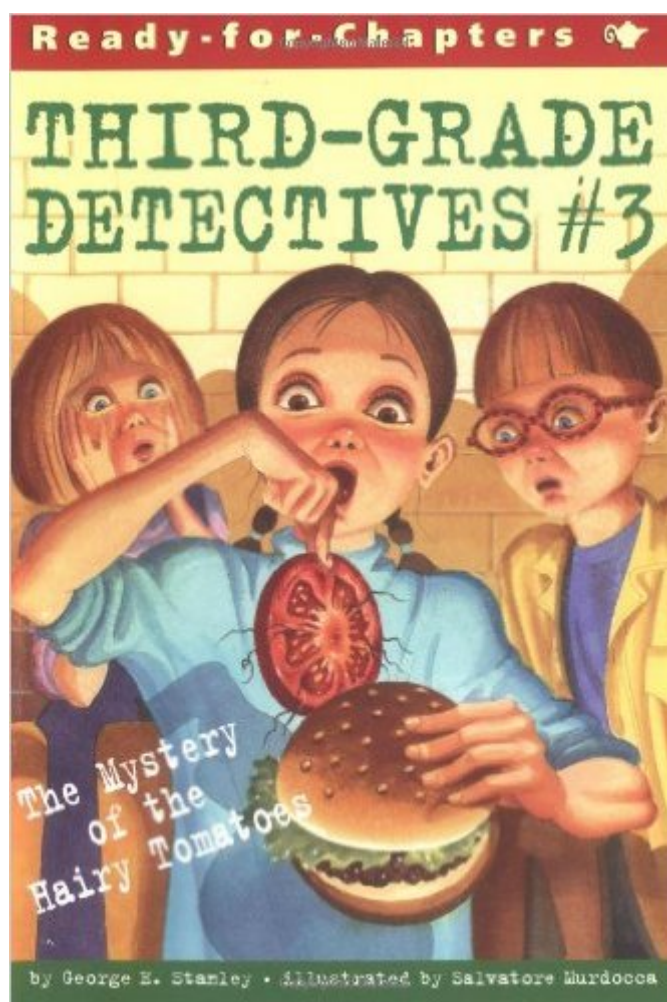

If your kids like mysteries and learning how police use science to solve crimes, this is the series for you! It's wonderful - and non-threatening. My kids read these books over and over. They're having fun and learning at the same time.

My Granddaughter and I had a great time reading a chapter or two each night as a bedtime story. She just entered second grade as was able to successfully read the story when it was her turn (we took turns reading 1-2 pages each). She could read probably 95 - 98% of the words in the book and it was a great learning experience sounding out and understanding the meaning of the words she was unfamiliar with, e.g. "evidence". She was immediately interested by the funny title and I've since ordered her a couple more of the Third Grade Detective stories.

My son is 8 years old and really enjoys reading the the "Third Grade Detective" series. He normally reads one of these books in about 1 hour. They are written at a level he can comprehend and enjoy. We have the whole collection with the exception of a few that are out of stock (we are eagerly awaiting their arrival). Delivery service was prompt, and exceeded expectations.

This is a really good series for young boys and girls who are having a hard time with reading. Its about 2-3 grade level and appeals to kids with a liking for solving things. I think the subject matter would appeal to [...] who read well too. I start out reading it with my grandsons and when they get interested, I find something I just have to do - but let them read on their own until I get back. Seems to work!
